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What's on in Normandy?




Celebrating the 80th anniversary of its liberation on 24 August, Evreux (Eure) is organising various festivities including its 25th edition of its acclaimed **comic book festival**. 50 authors will present their work and one of the main themes of the festival will be World War II.

Les Traversées Tatihou is a music festival taking place on the small island of Tatihou right in front of Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue (Manche). Just like to reach Elizabeth Castle in Jersey, you can walk to the island at low tide or take an amphibious boat to reach the festival and enjoy the traditional music coming from all around the world from 20 to 25 August.
