Scallop fishing season opens on 1<sup>st</sup> of October, kicking off a series of festivals celebrating it:

- **Toute la Mer sur un Plateau** (*A Taste of the Sea*) is the first on **5 & 6 October** in **Granville** (Manche).
- **Ouistreham Scallop Festival** (Calvados) on **19 & 20 October**.
- **Villers-sur-Mer Scallop Festival** (Calvados) on **28 & 29 October**.
