The **Nuits de la Lecture** is an annual celebration of literature and storytelling that takes place **across France** from **23 to 26 January**. Organised by the French Ministry of Culture, this event invites people of all ages to explore the joys of reading through a wide range of activities held in libraries, bookstores, cultural venues... Les Puces Rouennaises is a famous antique fair taking place in **Rouen** (Seine-Maritime) from **17 to 19 January**. It was created in 1981 which makes it one of the oldest flea markets in France. Every year, it gathers hundreds of exhibitors and thousands of visitors that can uncover a variety of treasures: antique or vintage items, works of art, books...
